He is a high energy dog which means he will need to be exercised on a regular basis. A daily brisk walk or run would be ideal. He would probably excel in agility training, he has an incredible athletic ability. However if you sit down on the couch, you will have a cuddler with you as he just wants to be where you are and loves to be near you. Buster has made an impression as an affectionate loyal companion.

- Housebroken—Buster uses a dog door when out of his crate and will potty on command while on a walk.
- Crate Trained—Buster sleeps in a crate at night and while his foster family is out of the house.
- High energy—Buster needs regular exercise.
- Medium size—he is 45 pounds and won't grow any larger.
- He comes on command but does need to attend obedience classes with a new owner. He is very eager to please and food motivated.
- Buster is nervous around children since he has not been exposed to them regularly. A placement in a house without children would do best.
- An experienced owner is desired for this breed. Elderly, first-time dog owners and homes with children would be best with another breed.
